

Jameson Ranch Equipment List

This list is not absolutely rigid and you may substitute. We do not have a camp store, so bring what you need:

BEDDING

If you are using the outdoor sleeping porches, a warm sleeping bag with extra blanket and a pillow are recommended. We provide the cot and mattress. Nights can get cool here at 4600 ft elevation.

If you are in an inside facility, the beds have sheets and blankets provided. Kids often still enjoy having a sleeping bag.

CLOTHING

Old or comfortable cloths are very suitable. Don't forget your swim suit for the pool and lake and a warm sweater/jacket for cool nights.

SHOES

Comfortable walking / hiking shoes are advised. Boots for horseback riding need to have solid covered toes (leather is best) with relatively smooth soles (no lug soles please) and a defined heel. These features are for safety when riding western saddle. We have a boot bank with a limited amount of sizes. Outdoor sleeping porches use outdoor showers and sandals or Tivas work well here.

TOILET ARTICLES

Bring a towel and washcloth, soap and shampoo and normal toiletries like tooth brush and hair supplies. Sun screen and insect repellent are good options. Outdoor sleeping porches have running cold water but no electricity.

OTHER SUPPLIES

A flashlight for the path after campfire at night, a hat for sun protection and a water bottle are good ideas.

White clothing like Shirts, socks, etc for Tie Dying

OPTIONAL

Day pack... camera... any personal sporting equipment (like fishing gear, bikes, or archery gear that fits you and you enjoy) you are welcome to bring. We provide program equipment and safety gear for all of our programs.
